From Interstate 70 take Highway 87 south. Go 10 miles to Prairie Home. Turn Right onto J and go 5 miles to O and turn left. Go 5.6 miles on O to Oakland Church Road and turn right (There is a small sign for the church). Zion Church and Cemetery are the 1st church you come to on the left.
