History:

"The Schmidt family has lived on this land for sixty-five years or more. They have built a new fence around the cemetery in 1967; and the cemetery was moved and the graves decorated on memorial Day, 1971. There are twenty or more marked graves of the remains of early Cooper County Pioneers. There may be many unmarked graves, also. It is known that some Negro children were buried here in early days."

This list was recorded by Mrs. Lloyd Wolfe, Mrs. W. H. Flanagan, and Mr. Oscar Schmidt in June 1971. Additions in red are from the Cooper County Record of Deaths.
