Ruth Kerr's letter 25 Feb. 1982: When he went back to Pennsylvania, "the 'old devil' told them that Abigail was dead and he married her sister. When she (Charlotte) died he went back to Missouri with four children,' Lish,' Isaac, Sarah and I don't the other one. I think it was Jane."

He married Abigail White in Delaware Co., Ohio 26 May 1836. According to IGO, he remarried Abigail Simmons 11 March 1866 in Putnam Co., Missouri. [LSD Batch No. M515632.]

It would figure that Russell Simmons left Abigail White about 1845/6, leaving her with a new-born child. The last child of Russell and Abigail was b. 1844. Russell and Charlotta were living with a 9-year-old child in PA in 1850 census. If this was the first child of Russell and Charlotta, it was b. 1840/41. The second child of the 1850 census was born ca 1844 and the third child was b. 1845/6. Taking into account the fact that the last child of Russell and Abigail was b. in 1844, it is probable that all three of these children in PA were children of Charlotte and a Burleen husband, not Russell's. These children do not appear with Russell and Abigail in the 1870 census back in MO. The last

child of Russell and Charlotta was born 1863 and probably was Russell's. So Charlotta must have died ca 1863-64. Thus I conclude that Charlotte was married to a Burleen and had three children by him.

Lou Pero says Russell Simmons never married Charlotta (no source; see 2000 E-mail) and he never divorced Abigail. Lillie Shipp says Charlotta was Abigail's cousin. (So a Simmons or a Wheery or a White?).

Could Charlotte have been a White by a brother of Paul White? Very possibly. The 1830 Census of Crawford Co., PA has a Paddy White residing with an Eli Berlin in Randolph Township (both # 019. his might link the White and Berlin (Burleen) families. (Needs lots more work).
