Atlas Survey:

1877 Land Atlas – a church and cemetery symbol on the John Carville land.

1915 Land Atlas – a church and cemetery symbol on the Casper Langlotz land.

1978 Plat Book – no symbols on Viola Neef land.

1991 Plat Book – a cemetery symbol on the Georgiana Rau land.

History:

In the early 1990s, this cemetery was cleaned up and repaired by members of the family. At that time a consolidated listing of burials was generated. It is possible that other graves are located in this cemetery but the stones were buried under the accumulated debris.

A number of additions have been made to this cemetery. Those additions noted in red are from the Cooper County Record of Deaths. While the Cooper County Record of Deaths do not specify Jones Chapel Cemetery, they state "Methodist Episcopal South" Church in Pilot Grove. Jones Chapel was a ME South church. Additionally, the only other candidate for these burials would be Wesley Chapel located slightly south of Pilot Grove. However, the Wesley Chapel entries in the Cooper County Record of Deaths specifically state that cemetery. Additionally Wesley Chapel was not a Methodist Episcopal South Church. Finally these entries go a long way in explaining the empty spaces between tombstones in the Jones Chapel Cemetery.

Simmons	Benjamin C.; born 08 Jul 1822 in Delaware Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania; died 23 Jan 1877 in Cooper County, Missouri; son of Elisha Douglas and Mary Ann née Potter Simmons; husband of Sarah Ann nee Dinsmore Simmons, first wife; married 15 Oct 1843 in Benton County, Missouri; husband of Anna Catherine née Densman Simmons, second wife; married 04 Dec 1853 in Cole Township, Benton County, Missouri; grandfather of Ernest Simmons
Simmons	Effie; aged 1 1/2 years; no maker; no dates; son of John Simmons
Simmons	Sarah Ann née Dinsmore; born 1826 in Missouri; died 1853 or 1854 in Missouri; daughter of James E. and Eleanor Dinsmore; wife of Benjamin C. Simmons, first wife; married 15 oct 1843 in Benton County, Missouri; no marker
Volrath	George Francis; born 1906; died 1908; no marker; brother of Lee Volrath
