History:

The graveyard committee was directed in 1871 to lay off lots to be recorded on the church record. The cemetery adjoins the church grounds. The trustees of the church over see the upkeep of the graveyard and report to the church regularly.

A memorial marker in Mt. Nebo Cemetery bears the names and dates of those buried in the Old Hutchison Family Burial Plot. This burial place had been almost destroyed because of neglect and the trampling of stock over many years. In 1973, Mr. William Paxton Hutchison, Sr. in Minden, Louisiana, a descendant of this family, made a number of trips to this spot. After obtaining the consent of the remaining descendants, the consent of the cemetery board of Mt. Nebo Baptist Church, he gathered up all the fragments of stones and had them buried around the memorial marker. The remains of bodies were not removed.

Three Clark burials were interred in the "Old Hutchison Family Cemetery", in Section 25, T-47-N; R-18-w; about two miles south of Bell Air, Missouri on the Virgil Doty farm; just north of the present residence. The markers that remained there were removed to this cemetery and buried around a new memorial Marker here. There were twelve burials recorded at the old cemetery of the Clark, Hutchison, Tutt, and Tucker families. The bodies were not removed. This was done by members of the Hutchison family in 1973.

Additions are from various sources including the Cooper County Record of Deaths and may or may not have markers. A supplementary list for this cemetery would be the names of burials in the Old Hutchiston Cemetery
