Directions:

On the Carl Cole Farm only a short distance from the residence and in a small grove of trees. From the intersection of Route 5 and Route E (about 2 ¼ miles south of Bell Air, Missouri) take Route E west. Cross the Petite Saline Creek and then about ¼ mile to the farm of Mr. Carl Cole.

This cemetery was established by Mr. Henry Woolery on his land. The data and list of these graves were supplied by Mr. Chatham Read from a list he had recorded and a list made up by Mrs. Belle Woolery some years previously.

Oglesby	Mildred C. "Milly" née Woolery; born 14 Nov 1814; died 03 Nov 1882; daughter of Henry and Nancy née Corum Woolery; wife of Pleasant G. Oglesby
Oglesby	Pleasant G.; born 12 Mar 1804; died 01 Jul 1845; son of Pleasant Bailey and Elizabeth née Guillam Oglesby; husband of Mildred C. "Milly" née Woolery Oglesby
Unknown	Rough stone with "E. W."; no dates; possibly Emily Woolery; second wife of Abraham Woolery; died 31 Mar 1864
Unknown	Rough stone with "T. W."; no dates
Unknown	Stone with only 1819 and "W. J. R. M."
Unknown	Stone with only 1849 and "W. J. R. M."
Woolery	Abraham; born 17 Dec 1794; died 23 Dec 1846; son of Lawrence and Peggie née Horn Woolery; husband of Nancy née Ellison Woolery, first wife; husband of Emily Jane née Brannen Woolery, second wife
Woolery	Emily Jane née Brannen; born 1794; died 1846; no marker; second wife of Abraham Woolery
Woolery	F.; 19 May 1851
Woolery	H. W.; possibly Henry Woolery; died 11 Mar 1842; son of Lawrence and Peggy née Horn Woolery; husband of Nancy née Corum Woolery
Woolery	Henry; Note: Mr. Chatham Read thinks Mr. Henry Woolery is probably buried here as this cemetery was established on his land
Woolery	Joseph; died 14 Oct 1871; aged 69 years, 14 days; son of Lawrence and Peggy née Horn Woolery;

	husband of Nancy H. née Titsworth Woolery
Woolery	Joseph; died 15 Jan 1853; aged 12 years, 2 months, 20 days; killed by lightning; son of Joseph and Nancy Hamilton née Titsworth Woolery
Woolery	L.; 17 Sep 1850
Woolery	Lawrence; born 1739; died 09 Apr 1839at Palestien, Cooper County, Missouri; at age 100 years; husband of Peggy née Horn Woolery
Woolery	Nancy Hamilton née Titsworth; died 13 Jan 1875; aged 62 years, 1 month, 5 days; daughter of John Gabriel, Sr. and nancy née Hamilton Titsworth; wife of Joseph Woolery
Woolery	Nancy née Corum; born 1789 (?); died 28 Sep 1845; wife of Henry Woolery
Woolery	Nancy née Ellison; born 18 Mar 1800; died 04 May 1844; first wife of Abraham Woolery
Woolery	Peggy née Horn; died at age 96 years; born in Germany; wife of Lawrence Woolery; Note: thought to be buried here; no marker
Woolery	T.; died 18 Sep 1850;
Woolery	William Hamilton; died 28 Nov 1861; aged 18 years, 9 months; son of Joseph and Nancy Hamilton née Titsworth Woolery
