History:

This listing was taken from many sources. In order to provide some order to this listing, I have alphabetized the listing. Additionally, I have eliminated unmarked grave listings, foot stones, and not included the source of the entry.

In Feb 1841, Jacob F. Wyan, for the sum of five dollars deeded to the Mayor, the Council and the People of the City of Boonville and to their successors forever one acre for the purpose of a graveyard under the control of the Methodist Episcopal church, as the burial ground of said church. Although the ground was not officially set aside as a cemetery until 1841, burials appear to have taken place as early as 1818. At one time there was a large gate at the entrance to this cemetery.

This cemetery was compiled from the following sources: 1) Listing from an article written by Col. John B. Barnes, which appeared in the Boonville Daily News of March 18, 1938. It gives the history of "City Cemetery" and some human interest stories related to old monuments and markers found there; 2) History of Cooper County, Missouri by Elston J. Melton.; 4) Cooper County Court House lists; 7) Obituaries

In the original listing the Boonville and Bunceton Sunset Hills Cemeteries were combined. I have attempted to separate the two cemeteries. However, I am positive that some errors exist; especially in those entries derived from newspaper obituaries. If you find an error please notify the webmaster of this site.
